

INFORMATION FOR VISITORS

All visitors to the School should report to the Main Reception at the front entrance of the Mackintosh Building.

The School sits on a very steep hill. People with mobility difficulties may require assistance.

If you require assistance contact the Main Reception or Janitorial Services prior to arrival. We regret that wheelchair access to some buildings is restricted and that some areas within buildings are inaccessible to those who are unable to manage stairs. We are constantly improving access and will provide assistance where required.

Car Parking

A voucher system (from 8am until 10pm every day) for parking operated by the City Council applies in the streets surrounding the School. Vouchers may be purchased at local participating shops including the GSA Shop (access via 16 Dalhousie Street). The nearest public car park is located on Cambridge Street a short distance from the School.

The Hub, Pacific Quay

Visitors should report to the Reception on the ground floor. All facilities are accessible for wheelchair users. Limited visitor parking is available.

Public Transport

The main campus is located in the city centre. Visitors to the School using public transport should consult Traveline Scotland (0870 608 2608) for up to date advice on getting to the GSA via public transport.

It is approximately 20 minutes from Glasgow Airport by motorway and a short walk from Glasgow Queen Street and Glasgow Central mainline railway stations. The closest subway station is Cowcaddens and railway station is Charing Cross (North Clyde Line).

Visitors to the Hub using public transport can use the SECC Exhibition Centre Train Station (Argyle Line); the variety of bus routes which serve the area and within 1km of the Hub - the following services provide connections to north and south sides of the river at regular intervals - 3, 23, 23A, 24, 25, 36, 38, 39, 54, 55, 56, 89, 90 and 121; the subway, using Cessnock Subway Station which is only a few minutes walk.



Both the main campus and Pacific Quay are located next to CTC/Sustrans Cycle Routes. Bike parking is available at both campuses.
